

Some rules and comments

1. **No fighting:** If in the opinion of a ref you attempt to punch (even if it misses) or in any way physically intimidate another player (intentionally push, spit, kick etc.) you will be removed from the league roster for the remainder of the current season and the entire next season before you are considered for admission in the league in the future.
2. **Refs:** We will be using the same refs or refs that will make similar calls as previous years. That means they will make calls during **every game** that you might not think are correct or they will not make a call that you thought should have been called. If you cannot display good sportsmanship after a ref makes a mistake (in your opinion) please do not join the league. If you have paid I will refund your league fee. One technical the other team gets 2 shots and the ball. Two technical's you must leave the building. Three technical's please see the remedy in rule number one above for fighting.
3. **High School Rules:** Our league will use high school rules with a few technical exceptions. We use 9 minute quarters, reset team fouls each quarter, allow 3 point shots from the corners while standing on the 3 point line (refs judgment call) probably a few others that I can't think of right now.
4. **Team Captains:** Each team will select a team captain. This player will be responsible for handling player substitutions and will also be a contact person for the team if a player cannot make a game. If the captain is not present for a game another player will be selected for that game.
5. **Playing time:** We play 9 minute quarters and in the past it seems that some players would divide 9 by 2 and come up with 6 or some number greater than 4:30. We will stop the game clock as close to 4:30 of each quarter for substitutions. Substitutions only this is not a time out. The team captain will be responsible for designating at the **start of each quarter** the players that will leave the floor at the 4:30 substitution. At the 4:30 mark anyone on the bench at that time will have a chance to enter the game unless they do not want to play at that time. If they choose not to play it will be up to the team captain to substitute if the player wants to enter the game before the next quarter. Every player will have the opportunity to play half a game if all ten players are present. It is expected that if a team has only 6 players in attendance, **that the playing time will be split among all players – e.g. if only 6 players are present, 4 players do not play the entire game and 2 players play half a game. The game time will be distributed among all players present.**
